





This document aims to offer a transparent account of Culture Vultures' ongoing collaboration and mutual respect with TheAnou.com and AtlasWoolSupply.com. Since 2013, Culture Vultures has maintained communication and professional alignment with The Anou and Atlas Wool Supply (AWS). Both The Anou and AWS, it should be noted, were founded by Dan Driscoll, hereby mentioned as DD, who currently directs the AWS. Hamza Cherif D"Ouezzan, hereby mentioned as HCO, directs The Anou. This record outlines distinct points of engagement that reflect shared values of artisan empowerment, transparency, and responsible cultural exchange over 13 years.

There were hundreds of emails in Culture Vultures' inbox referencing The Anou and later Atlas Wool; this document highlights key examples that represent the range of activities and engagements

- **2013** Initial correspondence between **Jessica Stephens**, Founder and Director of Culture Vultures, herby referred to as **JS**, and **DD**, identifying shared goals in artisan representation and ethical practice.
- **2014** Culture Vultures launched its first artisan residency; correspondence with **DD** acknowledged overlapping missions in community-based artisan engagement.
- **2017** Recommendation of The Anou to New York academics preparing student programs in Morocco as an example of ethical and transparent cooperation.
- **2017 ongoing** Advice to travellers to visit heritage carpet cooperatives for context, followed by The Anou for direct, ethical purchasing.
- **2018** Referral by Culture Vultures of a Fulbright researcher to The Anou for a nonprofit and cooperative study.
- **2018** Contact with **DD** exploring group visits to The Anou and AWS—early groundwork for *Textile Quest* development.
- **2019** Resident artist Sarah Kunst was introduced to The Anou through Culture Vultures; she later worked as a design consultant for the Anou.
- **2019** Visit by **JS**, of Culture Vultures to The Anou's Mohammedia base to discuss design and sustainability, and further build relations.
- **2022 JS** outreaches to several riad owners from Fez to arrange an introduction of the Anou, its practices, and offerings for potential clients.
- **2022** Visit by **JS** and a Culture Vultures, artisan tour guide to The Anou to model alternatives to exploitative carpet-tour visits and purchases.
- **2022** Recommendation of The Anou to a luxury travel company; **JS** (not under Culture Vultures) arranged the visit, the payment, and encouraged ongoing direct paid visits The Anou.

- **2023** Culture Vultures recommended The Anou to a *Lonely Planet* travel guide writer.
- **2023** Proposal for *Map of Moroccan Carpets* poster allocating 10% of profits to The Anou, as per correspondence with **HCO**.
- **2023** *Textile Quest* participants attended a dyeing workshop at The Anou, arranged via **HCO**.
- **2024** An Anou representative wa sinvited to join a *Textile Quest* artisan round-table to present and pitch The Anou to participating artisans in Tetouan.
- **2024** Continued recommendation of The Anou and AWS to travel designers and research groups seeking responsible engagement.
- **2025** Culture Vultures organized a regional artist-residency gathering and invited The Anou to participate in network-building among other residency programs in the Fez region.
- **2025 J.S** proposed retailing Anou products and AWS eco-soap at Boutique Laaroussa (as an independent consultant); terms stated by **DD** of the AWS were considered unreasonable, the products did not match the visual aesthetic and the prospects were declined by Boutique Laaroussa.

October 2025 The program for Culture Vultures' upcoming Textile Quest group in November is expressed by both **HCO** and **DD** to be in jeopardy for reasons explained in the <u>linked blog</u>.

This account reflects over a decade of shared aspirations and respectful exchange, affirming Culture Vultures' enduring belief in open dialogue and responsible partnership with both The Anou and Atlas Wool Supply.
